



Cape Santa Maria, Long Island, Bahamas (MYLS) November 10-14, 2019

Come with us as we return to the Cape Santa Maria Beach Resort on the northern end of Long Island in the Bahamas! The resort is situated on a beach that is recognized as one of the top 10 best beaches in the world. The four-mile long beach is pure white sand and is free of coral and rocks. You can wade out 50 feet and are only waist deep. A barrier reef protects the beach from large waves. Airport:

The airport is Stella Maris, MYLS. There is no landing fee for single engine planes, however there is a \$10 per day parking fee. Fuel is available. A cab from the airport to the resort is about \$36.00 for two people and \$2.00 for each additional person.

Flying to the Bahamas is easy. If you would feel more comfortable, there will be a group fly over from Fort Pierce, FL, St. Lucie County International Airport (KFPR) on Sunday, November 10. SEBS Trip Captain Michael Turner will be available at KFPR in the Tiki Restaurant from 8 am – 9 am to answer your questions. All participants in the group fly-over should arrive by 9 am, and one aircraft will be launched every 10 minutes.
